Dear Ms. Lynn:

This is in response to your labeling amendment wherein you are discontinuing your plans to use a separate label for Directions for Use and discontinuing your plans to use the two small adhesive labels for the handle of the applicator tool. (The labeling we have received from you for the subject amendment is the main label, which is printed on the box, and the small adhesive label, which stays on the bottle that is sold in the box.)

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted before the product is released for shipment. If the main label is a cardboard box, then send a photocopy rather than the box itself.

1. On the main label (i.e., the labeling on the outside of the box), in the Statement of Practical Treatment, delete the words, "Drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available."

2. On the main label, in the Storage and Disposal section, include the statement, "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."


