**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Use for general disinfection in hospitals, public rooms, homes, restaurants, barber and beauty shops, and pet quarters. Recommended for walls, floors, tables, counters and glass, metal, plastic, tiled, porcelain and finished wood surfaces.

**FOR DISINFECTION**

1. Flush away surface soils with water where possible.
2. Clean with a solution of 4 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water.
3. Rinse with clear water.
4. Apply disinfecting solution so as to thoroughly wet all surfaces. For non-porous, easily cleaned areas, make a disinfecting solution of 8 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. For porous surfaces, walls difficult to clean, or contagious disease areas, make a disinfecting solution using 16 ounces of DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. Surfaces directly contacting food must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

**FOR DEODORIZING**

For garbage cans and similar refuse areas, use a solution of 16 ounces per gallon of water. Spray to wet all surfaces.
