DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CONTROL OF CHINCH BUGS, SOD WEBWORMS (LAWN MOTHS), ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, EARWIGS, AND SOWBUGS (PILLBUGS):

Apply Do-it-Yourself Insect Control granules uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas, using any hand or power broadcast spreader (gravity or rotary type) for applying granular materials. Treat when insects first appear. Apply Insect Control at rate of 10 pounds of granules per 2,000 sq. ft. For more uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of granules in one direction, then apply the remaining half in one direction at a right angle to the

direction of the first application. Immediately after, sprinkle turf with 60 gallons of water per 2,000 sq. ft., so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Use chart to determine amounts of Insect Control granules and water required for smaller areas. Re-treat as necessary.

FOR CONTROL OF CERTAIN WHITE GRUBS (LARVAE OF EUROPEAN CHAFER AND JAPANESE BEETLE):

Use the recommended amount of granules for the specified area. Apply granules uniformly over the area treated and immediately water the area thoroughly. For best results, treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service for proper treatment time in your area.

FOR CONTROL OF HYPERODES (TURF GRASS) WEEVILS:

Use the recommended amount of granules for the specified area shown in chart. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-July. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service for the best treatment time in your area.

FOR CONTROL OF ANTS IN BURIED CABLE CLOSURES:

Apply 3 ounces of granules per square foot of enclosed surface area. This 3-ounce package is specifically intended for use in buried cable closures of power and utility companies and the telecommunications industry. Sample closures are telephone pedestals and transformer pads. Distribute granules uniformly.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: Do-It-Yourself Insect Control may be harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use. Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water and get prompt medical attention. Avoid breathing vapors or dust particles. Avoid contacting food crops. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Keep container closed. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, only by injection, is an antidote.
