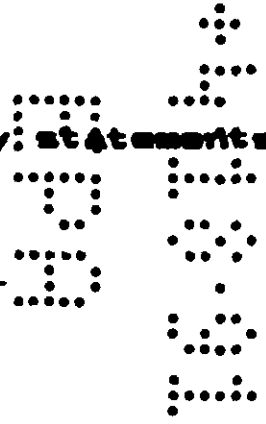

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR WASP AND HORNET CONTROL:** Spray from upwind position. Spray nest from distance of 8-10 feet. Spray until nest is thoroughly covered and all emerging wasps or hornets are contacted. To prevent insects from falling on skin and clothing, do not stand directly under nest.

**FOR ANT CONTROL: (MOUND CONTROL)** Install delivery tube on spray can. Begin spraying, then insert delivery tube into ant mound while maintaining spray delivery. Insert in several locations to maximum possible depths. Remove delivery tube, reinstall spray nozzle and spray external areas of the mound thoroughly.

**FOR FORAGING ANT CONTROL:** Use spray nozzle, spray directly on ants. Spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary.

**OTHER USES - OUTDOORS ONLY** For control of Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Spiders, Roaches, and Brown Dog Ticks: Spray infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of screen frames, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter or congregate. For Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks spray weeds and bushy non-crop vegetation. Repeat treatment as necessary. Do not spray desirable vegetation.

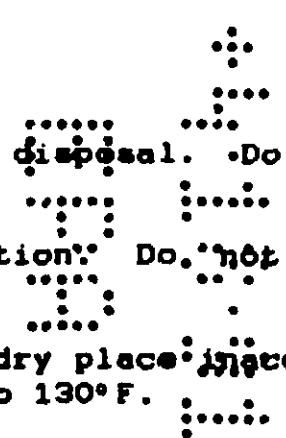
**FOR CONTROL OF ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, AND CRICKETS - INDOORS** Spray heavily into all cracks, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks and stoves. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry. Do not spray when or where food is exposed.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container.

**DISPOSAL** Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

**STORAGE** Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Temperature range 20°F to 130°F.
