FOR CLOTHING: To repel ticks, fleas and chiggers: (see **CAUTION** - Make liberal application along all openings of the clothing, such as inside the neck band, the fly and cuffs of trousers, tops of socks, eyelets of shoes and areas of clothing which may contact the ground, weeds or other growth.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and place in trash collection.
