A stamped copy "accepted with comments" of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) The "For sale to, use and storage only by utility industry....." and "This product is not for residential use" must be moved up to under the product name.
- 2) The Storage and Disposal heading and the "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal" statement are missing and must be added.
- 3) The Disposal Statement is inappropriate for Industry and must be revised.

Open the applicator dispenser lid two (2) notches and shake (broadcast left to right) the insecticide onto the ground, covering the area of the pad location, plus a two foot perimeter around the outside of the pad location. This container will cover up to a 100-sq. ft. area (an area 10' x 10'). Container holds the equivalent of 24, 4 oz. bags of Rainbow Fire Ant Killer. Plastic barrier required for poured-in place pads. Prior to pouring concrete, cover insecticide-treated surface with plastic barrier.

{For product to be used in combination with an herbicide:}

In areas where both vegetation and insect infestation require simultaneous control, this product may be mixed with Rainbow® Weed Killer. Mix only enough combined product to cover a pre-measured area and use all combined product at once. Mix at a ratio of 6 pounds of this product to 0.5 to 1 pound of Rainbow® Weed Killer and apply to cover 100 square feet. [Mix at a ratio of 3 pounds of this product to 0.25 to 0.5 pound of Rainbow® Weed Killer and apply to cover 50 square feet.] Apply with a shaker-type applicator or with any equipment capable of evenly distributing the mixture over the area to be treated. Application equipment is available from Rainbow Technology Corporation. All applicable directions, limitations and precautions on this label and the Rainbow® Weed Killer label must be followed.

Storage: Store in a clean, dry place. Protect container from rupture during storage and transport. If contents are spilled, sweep or scoop up material and place in another clean, dry container for reuse or disposal in accordance with this label.
