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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is a non-selective herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. It is recommended only for non-cropland industrial areas. 150 up to 300 pound applications of this product per acre usually result in a non-productive condition of the soil for a period of a year or more. The duration of non-productivity is dependent upon rainfall, soil type and other conditions.

This product should be applied as furnished with a shaker type applicator or with any hand-held equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated. Application equipment is available from Rainbow Technology Corporation.

For spot treatment with hand-held equipment: For the control of annual and most perennial weeds and grasses, this product may be applied as needed at rates up to the equivalency of 6 lb. ai/A (600 pounds per acre; on small plots 1.4 pound per 100 square feet. [8 ounces product per 40 sq. ft.]) Repeat spot treatment may be required when deep rooted perennial weeds are present. To obtain the best results, this product should be applied to the ground where it will be absorbed by the roots.

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Applications made early in the season have been found to give results superior to applications at a later seasonal date. This product may, however, be applied at any time of the year except when the ground is frozen. Maximum effectiveness in arid regions is obtained when application is made just prior to the rainy season.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply on or near desirable woody or herbaceous plants or on areas where their roots may extend because of possible injury to such plants. Thoroughly clean spreading equipment with a suitable chemical cleaner before using for other purposes (or do not use same spreading equipment for other purposes). Do not contaminate irrigation ditches or water used for domestic purposes. Do not use on croplands or any land to be used for subsequent cropping. Keep animals off treated areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: To maximize the shelf life of this product, store in dry area where the bag [container] is not likely to come in contact with moisture. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty bag [container]; wrap and discard in trash.

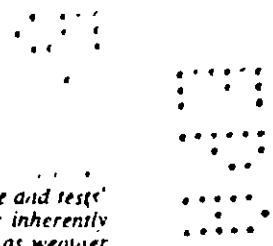
