This product is for sale to, use and storage only by utility and commercial or industrial service personnel.

For Use In and Around Telecommunications, Power, Utilities and Railroad Systems Equipment

For use in and around buried cables, cable television pedestals, cables, pad-mounted air conditioning units, pad-mounted electric power transformers, telephone cables, underground vaults, telecommunications equipment (boxes, closures, interfaces, pedestals, protectors and terminals), power and utilities equipment (camera housings, control panels, emergency light systems, fire alarm systems and lights/alarms) and railroad systems equipment (breaker boxes, railroad signals, traffic control boxes and signals, and transformer packs).

Rainbow Insect Tag is a self-contained, continuous release insecticide. It kills and controls Africanized honey bees, ants, bees, crickets, earwigs, fire ants, fleas, hornets, millipedes, roaches, scorpions, silverfish, sowbugs, spiders (including Black Widow and Brown Recluse), ticks, wasps, waterbugs and yellowjackets. It repels fire ants and cockroaches from enclosed utility equipment. Repels continuously.

Do not open until ready to use. Open outer package (do not remove tag from holder), secure tag(s) with ties. Due to various equipment sizes, the amount of product may vary, however not more than two tags per three cubic feet is recommended. Use in exterior areas at points of entry. Do not place product where it will interfere with moving parts of equipment. Do not place tag on outside of equipment nor in exposed locations where direct contact with children, pets, food or clothing is likely to occur. Replace tag(s) when effectiveness is diminished to maintain control.

For wasps, bees, Africanized honey bees and yellowjackets inside closures, flush out insects with an EPA-registered product before placement inside equipment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store unopened in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container wrap tags and container and discard in trash.
