

Shake Well Before Use. Do not use as a space spray. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially processed or prepared. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. **Before spraying insects or nests, give the can a short burst away from the nest to ensure proper pressure. Contact with roof shingles may cause discoloration or other unwanted effects.**

Cover or remove all food processing surfaces and/or handling equipment during application. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After application in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, cafeterias and similar facilities wash, with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination, all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled.

Nonfood/feed areas where this product can be applied are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

For Wasp & Hornet Control: (1) Spray from an upwind position. (2) Hold can in an upright position with nozzle end pointed toward nest while standing 6 to 12 feet away. (3) Begin spraying nest. (4) Thoroughly spray nest, but not to the point of runoff. (5) When possible, apply in early morning or at dusk when most of the insects have returned to the nest and are less active.

For Yellow Jacket & Bee Control: (1) Spray in a sweeping motion on external insects flying around the opening of the nest. (2) Move forward to the nest opening and spray directly into the nest hole. (3) When possible, apply in early morning or at dusk when most of the insects have returned to the nest and are less active. (4) For large nests more than one can may be necessary.

For Outdoor Cockroach, Fly, Flea and Brown Dog Tick Control: Thoroughly spray infested areas including outside surfaces of screen frames, doors, window frames, foundations, patios or other places where insects may congregate or enter premises. Reapply as reinfestation and environmental conditions warrant.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame. **Disposal:** Do not puncture or incinerate! **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
