Matey is a cleaner, disinfectant, and sanitizer designed for general household and light industrial cleaning. For use on walls, floors and any inanimate hard surface. When used as directed, Matey will deodorize those areas which are hard to keep fresh smelling, such as GARBAGE CANS, SINK TOPS AND BATHROOM AREAS which are prone to odors caused by the growth of microorganisms. When used at 2 ounces per gallon, it is effective against pathogenic fungi, staphylococcus aureus and salmonella choleraesuis.

USE DIRECTIONS;

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTION:

Use Matey at a dilution rate of 2 oz. or 4 tablespoons per gallon of water. This will provide 500 p.p.m. active quaternary in the use solution. This is sufficient for general disinfection, fungicidal activity and deodorizing.

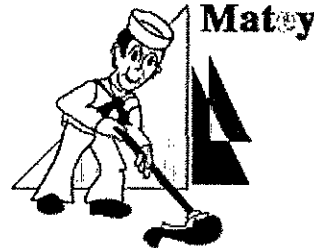
For best results, use the Matey use dilution with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surface areas. Allow to remain in contact with the surface for at least 10 minutes, then rinse the surface thoroughly with water. For heavily soiled surfaces, a pre-cleaning step is required using Matey All Purpose Cleaner. Before using this product, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the area or carefully protected.

FOR FOOD CONTACT SURFACE SANITATION:

Use Matey at a dilution rate of 1-1/2 tablespoons per gallon of water. This will provide 200 p.p.m. of active quaternary in the use solution. Food particles and soil must be removed by a pre-flush, pre-scrape, or, if necessary, a presoak treatment. Items to be sanitized must be washed using a suitable detergent followed by a potable water rinse prior to application of the sanitizing solution. For dishes, utensils, and glassware immerse in solution for at least 1 minute. For tables and countertops, apply with a cloth or sponge, leave on for at least 1 minute, then rinse thoroughly.

FOR HOSPITAL DISINFECTION:

Use Matey at a dilution rate of 3 oz. or 6 tablespoons per gallon of water. This will provide 750 p.p.m. of active quaternary in the use solution. Follow the use directions for GENERAL DISINFECTION.
