#### **DIRECTIONS:**

For maximum disinfecting and deodorizing action, apply in concentrations described below. Wet all surfaces thoroughly with mop, brush or cloth and allow to remain at leas: 10 minutes before rinsing.

### TO DISINFECT AND DEO-DORIZE:

Toilet Bowls—Add 2 fl. oz. (¼ cup) undiluted to bowl. Bathrooms, Showers, Kitchen Cabinets—Add 2 fl. oz. :o 1 gallon warm water. Rinse. Garbage Cans—Remove gross filth and soil deposits before wetting all surfaces. Use 2 fl. oz. per gallon of water. Rinse.

#### TO CLEAN AND DEO-DORIZE:

Laundry—Add 4 fl. oz. (½ cup) to average load during wash or rinse cycle. Fcllow with hot rinse. Floors, Walls, Cars—Use 2 fl. oz. per gallon of warm water. Rinse.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
