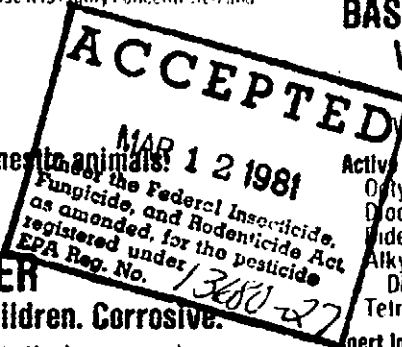

Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of water. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Fungicide or skin damage may contraindicate the use of ointments. Directions for Use GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

OZAN 256 is a proven one-step cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-fungicide-virucide in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil.

Apply OZAN 256 to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks and bedframes with a cloth mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection — To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces, add 1 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At this use-level OZAN 256 is also virucidal and fungicidal.

Sanitizing — To sanitize porous or non-porous, non-food contact surfaces add 1 oz. per gallon of water.

1 oz. per gallon use-level. The broad spectrum activity of OZAN 256 has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against the following by the AOAC Use-Dilution test:

- Pseudomonas aeruginosa
- Staphylococcus aureus
- Salmonella choleraesuis
- Escherichia coli
- Klebsiella pneumoniae
- Enterobacter aerogenes
- Salmonella schottmuelleri
- Streptococcus faecalis
- Shigella dysenteriae
- Brevibacterium ammagenes

AOAC Fungicidal Test

OZAN 256 is effective against Trichophyton mentagrophytes (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise areas, dressing rooms, etc.

Virucidal Performance

At 1 oz. per gallon use-level OZAN 256 was evaluated in the presence of 10% serum and found to be effective against the following viruses: Herpes Simplex (a member of the virus family that causes infectious mononucleosis), Vaccinia (representative of the pox viruses), and Influenza A (the Hong Kong flu virus) on inanimate environmental surfaces.

Sanitizing Non-Food Contact Surfaces (such as floors, walls, tables, etc.) At 1 oz. per gallon use-level 30 second contact time, OZAN 256 is an effective sanitizing agent in waters of up to 600 ppm hardness against Staphylococcus aureus and Klebsiella pneumoniae in the presence of 5% serum on porous and non-porous environmental surfaces.
