DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To prepare the standard cleaner-sanitizer solution for general dairy farm use dissolve 3 level tablespoonsful LO-COUNT in 3 gallons of warm water.

Before Morning Milking:

1. Draw 3 gallons of clear, unused hot water through each milker unit. Also rinse other utensils.
2. Clean the udders by adding 3 tablespoonsful of LO-COUNT to 3 gallons of warm water. If solution rack is used, use one tablespoon of LO-COUNT per gallon of water. No other chemical should be used with LO-COUNT.

After Morning Milking:

1. Immediately draw at least one pailful of clean warm water through each unit.
2. Dismantle machine, including air hose, and immerse with other utensils in cleaner solution (3 tablespoonsful LO-COUNT to each 3 gallons of water). Soak at least one-half hour.
3. Brush all parts inside and out.
4. Hang up without rinsing.

Before Night Milking:

1. Draw 3 gallons of clear, unused hot water through each milker unit. Also rinse other utensils.
2. Clean the udders by adding 3 tablespoonsful of LO-COUNT to 3 gallons of warm water. If solution rack is used, use one tablespoon of LO-COUNT per gallon of water. No other chemical should be used with LO-COUNT.

After Night Milking:

1. Rinse milker and other utensils with warm water.
2. Flush milker with fresh cleaner solution. (3 tablespoonsful of LO-COUNT to each 3 gallons of water).
3. Wash other utensils.
4. Store without rinsing.
