HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not use this product in commercial food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other places where food is prepared or processed.

HAZARDS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Do not spray directly in/on eyes, mouth or genitalia of pets. Do not treat or cause exposure to kittens or puppies less than four weeks old. Do not use this product on pregnant animals.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

Do not induce vomiting unless directed by a physician.

IF INHALED: Remove affected person to fresh air.

IF ON SKIN: Wash affected areas with Soap and Water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Consult physician if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Contains under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

Directions for use: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control fleas, ticks and lice: Holding can upright, spray the animal with short bursts from a distance of 10 or 12 inches. Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the portion fur directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Spraying a cat 20 to 30 seconds or an average size dog 30 to 45 seconds is usually sufficient. Repeat application weekly if necessary to control reinfestation.

DIRECTIONS TO KILL TICKS: Ticks are tough and a spray directed at the ticks is preferred, if possible.

HELPFUL HINT: To control reinfestation, weekly applications with Four Paws[®] Flea and Tick Killer is recommended. And don't forget to spray on bedding and other frequented areas as needed. Do not treat or cause exposure of kittens or puppies under 4 weeks of age.

Storage and Disposal:

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
