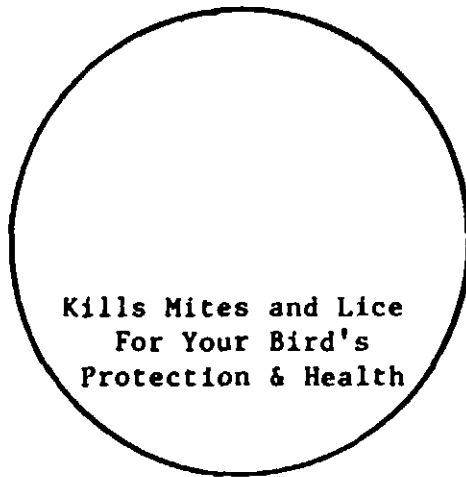

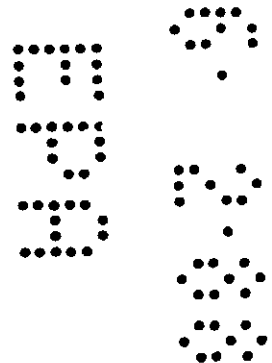

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

DIRECTIONS: Shake well before use. To kill lice on your bird, leave bird(s) in cage. Remove food and foodstuffs. Spray directly on birds, from a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Avoiding the bird's eyes and face, spray lightly utilizing 3 or 4 pumps.

To kill mites, remove bird(s), food and water cups, etc., and spray cage thoroughly by holding bottle at least one foot from surface utilizing 5 or 6 pumps. This treatment may be done twice a week. Clean cage thoroughly at regular intervals.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and away from heat and direct sunlight. Protect from freezing.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
