The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Delete the following safety claims:  
For your birds protection and health  
For your bird's protection and health

Move the following statements, as revised, from the Precautionary Statements and place them in the Directions for Use, under a subheading "Use Restrictions"  
Do not spray food, foodstuffs or drinking water. Cover or remove food, foodstuffs and drinking water.  
Cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Delete from the marketing claims the following, as it is vague and may lead to misuse:  
"other areas"

The net contents must be displayed in fluid ounces. Metric measure is optional.

Under the Directions for Use, delete the subheading "Directions"

Delete the following enhanced efficacy claim:  
Will leave your bird and cage free from mites and lice.



**Recycled/Recyclable**  
Printed with Soy/Canola Ink on paper that  
contains at least 50% recycled fiber

In accordance with PR Notice 2007-4, and 2007-1 add the following to the disposal instructions:

Nonrefillable container. If empty: Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call you local solid waste agency [or toll free number which meets the criteria of PR Notice 2007-1] for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

In accordance with PR Notice 2007-4, the label must display a batch code.

It is not clear what meaning the statement "Central Garden and Pet", located below the registrant name and address, conveys. Delete or clarify it. See the Label Review Manual for guidance on the registrant name and address.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance. As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or e:mail address.

Please note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility document (RED) for products contain pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide was published in the Federal Register on July 26, 2006. Additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide. For more information, see the following website:

### Statement of practical treatment

**if swallowed:** Contact a physician or poison Control Center  
immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by  
touching the back of your throat with finger.

**if inhaled:** remove person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if  
indicated.

**if on skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with  
plenty and soap and water.

**if in eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call physician if irritation  
persists.

**Directions for use:** It is a violation of federal law to use this product in  
a manner inconsistent with it's labeling.

**Directions:** Shake well before use. To kill lice on your bird, leave bird(s)  
in cage. Remove food and foodstuffs. Spray directly on birds from 12 to  
18 inches away. Avoid the birds eyes and face, spray lightly utilizing 3 or  
4 pumps.

To kill mites remove bird(s), food and water cups, etc., and spray cage  
thoroughly by holding bottle at least one foot from surface utilizing 5 or  
6 pumps. This treatment may be done twice a week. Clean cage  
thoroughly at regular intervals.

**Storage:** Store in original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to  
children and away from heat and direct sunlight. Protect freezing.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several  
layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
