The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Repeat as necessary for control.

Not recommended for puppies under the age of 6 weeks.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and warm water.
