INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

PROBE METHOD: Locate runway with sharp stick by probing at a distance of 18 inches from an active pocket gopher mound. Insert a teaspoonful of bait into runway, close the hole so that it is tight and taking care to prevent covering bait placement with dirt.

BURROW BUILDER: Space artificial burrows approximately twenty feet apart at a depth of natural burrow. Set mechanism to feed bait at the rate of approximately two pounds per acre. Burrow builder constructs the best burrows in moist soil. In dry soil the burrows will crumble and cave in.



POISON



ANTIDOTE: CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY. If less than ten minutes have passed since the poison was taken, give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water to remove unabsorbed strychnine. Treatment by this method after ten minutes may induce onset of convulsions. If convulsions occur, followed by respiratory failure, administer artificial respiration. Keep victim lying down in a quiet, darkened room, and keep him warm.

When placement of strychnine-treated grain presents a hazard to wildlife, pets or livestock, all placements must be made in or under cover. Grain baits exposed on bare ground are highly toxic.
