Point nozzle upward, direct spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.
