The revised Confidential Statement of Formula agrees with the label and is acceptable. The alternate source of supply of the raw material for the active ingredient is also acceptable. This data, upon review, has placed this product in toxicity category 3 for eye irritation. The special (child-resistant) packaging requirement is therefore removed, and the following labeling changes must be made.

1. The statement "Do not get in eyes..." should be revised to read "Avoid contact with eyes and skin."
2. Change the signal word "Warning" to "Caution."
3. Delete the ingestion first aid statements from the Statement of Practical Treatment section.
4. Delete the Note to Physician section.

We understand from your December 18 telecon with Mr. Prominski that the Confidential Statement of Formula submitted October 15, 1984, is correct.

The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you:


1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Aerosol Detergent/Disinfectant has been designed specifically for Household and Institutional cleaning and disinfecting in Homes, Nursing Homes, Hospitals, Offices, Schools, Motels and Hotels.

DISINFECTION, DEODORIZATION, AND CLEANING:

To disinfect, hard non-porous surfaces such as bathroom tiles, walls, fixtures, shower stalls, sinks, bathtubs, hampers, tables, and chairs, proceed as indicated below:

(1) Shake can before using. (2) Hold six to eight inches from surface to be treated. (3) Spray area until it is covered with a white foam. Allow foam to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing necessary. (4) Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop or sponge. The product will not leave grit or soap scum.

For heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before treatment.

MILDEWSTAT—To control mold and mildew on pre-cleaned hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops) spray surfaces to be treated making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMAN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

When used as directed, it will demonstrate effective disinfection against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, thus meeting the requirements of the EPA Disinfectant Registration Act (the product is registered).
