COMPOSITION

APPLICATION

Delta K-160 is used to control algae, bacteria and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers. Prior to its use, systems should be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 1.0 quarts to 2.0 quarts per 1,000 gallons of water in the system to provide a concentration of 40 ppm to 80 ppm of active ingredient based on the total weight of the water in the system is recommended. Repeat until control is established. Subsequent additions of 0.5 quarts to 1.0 quarts per each 1,000 gallons of water in the system should be employed every one to two weeks or oftener if observations indicate the need. The frequency of addition will depend on the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological infestation. Slug additions should be made into the sump of the water cooling tower.

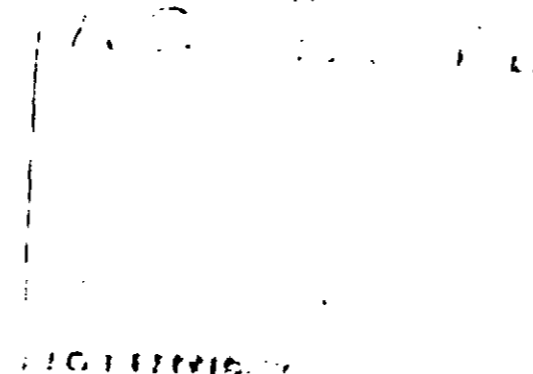
