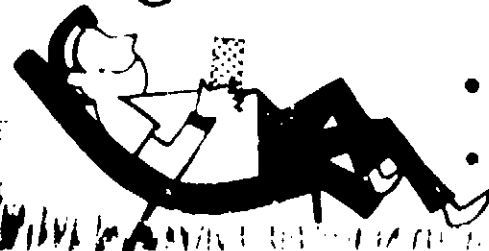

With MOWLESS

MOWLESS IS A remarkable new chemical discovery which slows growth of most grasses without harm. A neat appearance is maintained all season without the weekly troublesome job of mowing. MOWLESS is applied only ONCE A SEASON. But it reduces mowings to ONCE or maybe TWICE A SEASON. In addition, it eliminates most broadleaf weeds.

WHERE TO USE: MOWLESS can be used on a grass at least 3 years old, which is green, healthy and actively growing. It is especially useful for hard to mow areas - steep slopes, edges of home lawns, golf courses, airports, schools, municipalities, industrial sites, etc.

WHEN TO USE: MOWLESS may be used from APRIL 1 thru NOVEMBER 20. Spring is ideal. The grass then is in a growing state and will absorb the chemical best - thus giving the longest period of growth retardation. If spraying is delayed beyond the early period in spring, another mowing may be necessary. Under these conditions, allow one week AFTER SPRAYING for distribution of chemical within the plant, then mow again. DO NOT REPEAT THE SPRAYING.

Applied in fall, MOWLESS WILL slow the next season's grass growing. MOWLESS must be applied when grass is still actively growing, before it becomes dormant and brown up to about November 20. Results are better when applied nearer to the time when grass becomes dormant.

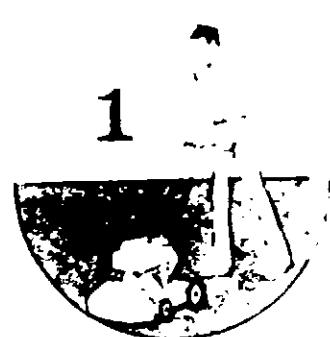

Use only a complete set of Mow-Less sprayer and that sprayer which is capable of applying Mow-Less to a lawn. Do not use a SPRINKLER CAN.

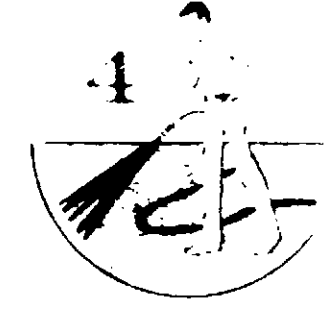
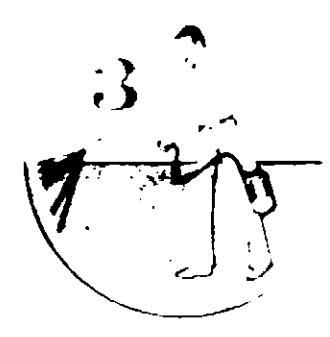
Mow lawn

Mow lawn
completely free of
clippings, leaves
and debris.

Water lawn until
water runs off.
Do not use fertilizer.



Remove any debris, clippings, leaves, etc. with a
detergent and water solution. Do not use a
DO NOT RE-SEED lawn until after mowing.

After spraying, wait nine days before mowing. Do not mow until grass has dried.
