The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the finished product label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1. Correct the spelling of the active ingredients such that they appear as follows

Pyrethrins 0.20%
Piperonyl butoxide* 1.18%

- 2. A copy of the submitted product label has been retained for your reference. Correct the spelling of the words which have been highlighted in orange

- 3. Revise the precautionary treatment section so that it appears as follows

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED Do not induce vomiting. Contact a physician or a Poison Control Center immediately

IF INHALED Remove victim to fresh air and apply artificial respiration if indicated

IF ON SKIN Wash contaminated skin with soap and water. Contact physician if irritation persists

IF IN EYES Flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists

4. Revise the precautionary text to appear as follows:

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Remove pets from area to be treated and cover or remove fish aquariums. Food should be covered or removed during treatment. All surfaces where food will be handled should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using.

5. The use sites (for example, for household use) for this pesticide must be listed under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section of the product label.

6. Refer to the Agency letter dated May 1, 1991, specifically points 1 and 2.

a. Submit the product-specific product chemistry for this pesticide.

b. Enclosed you will find a Confidential Statement of Formula. Fill out this form in its entirety and submit this information to the Agency.

(1) Column 12 must contain the EPA Registration Number of the source product(s) for the individual active ingredients.

(2) Column 13a must declare the weight per batch of the individual formulation component, and the total batch weight must be provided in box 17. Ensure that the specific unit of measure (i.e. pounds, grams, etc.) is declared and is consistent for each formulation component.

(3) It is not acceptable to declare "nil" for the weight and certified limits of the dye component. The actual amount (column 13a), % by weight (column 13b), and the upper and lower certified limits (columns 14a and 14b) must be supplied.

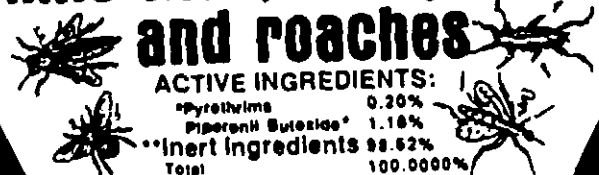
