The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you.

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. The active ingredient is required on the front panel. Revise accordingly.
 - b. Delete the sentence "No potable rinse is required" wherever it appears on the label.
 - c. Revise the term "First Aid" to "Statement of Practical Treatment."
 - d. Include the heading "Storage and Disposal" and add the subheading "Pesticide Disposal and Container Disposal." Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for the appropriate Storage and Disposal statement.
 - e. Revise the sentence "Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate" to read "Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling."

- f. On the side panel above the word Danger, include the following

Precautionary Statements
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals


- g. Delete the word "milk."
- h. The statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" must be placed directly over the signal word "DANGER" (front panel only).
- i. Revise "Use Directions" to "Directions for Use."
- j. Revise the statement "See other precautionary and first aid statements on side panel" to "See side panel for additional precautionary statements."
2. Submit five (5) copies of final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

n-Alkyl (60% C₁₂, 30% C₁₄, 5% C₁₆, 5% C₁₈) dimethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides 5%
n-Alkyl (68% C₁₂, 32% C₁₄) dimethyl ethylbenzyl ammonium chlorides 5%

INERT INGREDIENTS 90%
100%

MESA SANITIZING RINSE is a concentrate and should be diluted before using.

USE DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT: For sanitization of previously cleaned food processing equipment and food utensils, dilute 1 ounce per 4 gallons of water to provide 200 ppm of active quarternaries. At this level, **No Potable Water Rinse** is required. Consult local health board for additional information.

DAIRIES: To sanitize dairy equipment such as tanks, lines, pails, and milk cans, first clean and rinse the equipment thoroughly. Then apply sanitizing solution containing 1 ounce to 4 gallons of water (200 ppm). At this level, **No Potable Water Rinse** is required. Consult local health board for additional information.

RESTAURANT AND BAR RINSE: Dishes, glassware, silverware, cooking utensils, remove food particles and scrubby fresh or presoaked and when necessary pre-rinse with soap or synthetic detergent. Rinse thoroughly with a potable water rinse and immerse in a sanitizing solution containing 1 ounce to 4 gallons of water. **No Terminal Potable Water Rinse Required.** To disinfect floors, walls, woodwork, and other hard surfaces such as sink tops, garbage pails, and restrooms,

use this product at 3 1/2 ounces per 5 gallons of water. Apply with cloth, mop, or sponge to insure thorough wetting of the surface. **At this concentration, a final rinse with Potable Water is Required.** At this level, this product will kill *Staphylococcus Aureus*, *Salmonella Choleraesuis*, and *Pseudomonas Aeruginosa* PHD-10, and the following viruses: *Influenza A₁*, *Herpes Simplex*, *Adenovirus type 2* and *Vaccinia Viruses* on environmental hard surfaces. For heavily soiled or contaminated areas, a pre-cleaning step is recommended. Contact time of at least 1 minute required for sanitization. Drain use solution from the surface and air dry.

DANGER
Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash off contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, or gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Expect to mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against convulsions, shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.
