### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Just mop or spray on as necessary. Aids in removing grease and leaves floors clean and fresh smelling.

**BATHROOM** - After toilet, toilet paper, toilet bowl, tub, clean and sanitize toilet, sink and toilet seat, use 1 tablespoon to 1 quart of water.
