**Sanitizing of Food Processing Equipment and other Hard Surfaces in Food Contact Locations.**

Sanitizing food processing equipment, dairy equipment, cooking utensils, dishes, silverware, glasses, sink tops, counter-tops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other hard non-porous surfaces.

Wash and rinse all articles thoroughly. Then apply a solution of 1 oz (200 ppm active) in 4 gallons of water. Surfaces should remain wet for at least 10 minutes followed by adequate draining and air drying. Sanitizing solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty. For mechanical application, use solution until it is no longer visible.

Sanitize sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment and other stationary hard surfaces by cloth or brush. Sanitize silverware, glasses, cooking utensils and other hard non-porous size food processing equipment can be sanitized by immersion in a 1 oz/4 gallon dilution of

**No Potable water rinse is necessary.**

At 100/274 gallons has a water tolerance of 500 ppm of hardness calculated as calcium when evaluated by the AOAC Germicidal and Antiseptic Sanitizer Method against *Escherichia coli* and *Staphylococcus aureus*.

Teat cups, flanks, and teats of dairy cows can be sanitized by washing with a solution of 1 oz

in 4 gallons of warm water.

Use a fresh towel for each cow. Avoid contamination of sanitizing solution by dirt and soil. Do not dip used towel back into sanitizing solution. When solution becomes visibly dirty, discard and provide fresh solution.

**DANGER**
