

To Dilute 10 % Germicin 50 For Use: For Germicin 600 PPM (1:1660 approx.) add and stir 1 oz. of Germicin 10 % in $1\frac{1}{2}$ gallons of water.

birections for use: For general disinfection of floors, walls, showers, toilet seats in hospitals and food processing plants: First, clean with a good detergent, not soap. If soap was used for cleansing, rinse with water before using Germicin. For mopping previously cleaned non-porous surfaces, use 600 PPM. Apply in a manner (wiping, mopping or scrubbing), and for a sufficient time, to assure the surface being treated is thoroughly wetted by the recommended use dilution.
