Roaches, water bugs, etc. for each 100 sq. ft. contact as much as possible. Pay attention to baseboard openings, broom closets, places, cracks, etc. spraying directly into cracks, crevices, etc. Apply by using a spray nozzle to deliver a true spray into air. Do not spray into room with mist. Keep doors and windows closed. Clean up and wash thoroughly. Do not in operation.
