DIRECTIONS FOR

Roaches, waterbugs, ants, flies, and other insects. Directing the spray in particular attention to pipe openings, baseboards, etc.

Files, mosquitoes, etc. Fill the room with the spray.

Clothes Moths: Use when spraying clothing. For the folds of garments storing clothing in storage containers are advisable.

Bedbugs: Spray tufts. Take beds apart. Repeat application.

For insects affecting stored food, NOT SPRAY DIRECTLY ON CEREALS — treatment. All food during treatment using product in operation.

To kill exposed stored food, tobacco, grain beetle, rice, etc. cubic feet of space. Pay particular attention to hiding places. Repeat application.

Sanitation is necessary to prevent grain and dust. Use handling equipment.
