2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 14955-32."
- b. Delete "Only for sale to, use and storage by service persons." Add in its place, "Recommended For Commercial and Industrial Use."
- c. Delete, "Petroleum Distillates . . . 98.75%," from the Active Ingredients listings. Add the 98.75% to the Inert Ingredients, which brings it to a total of 99.0%. In addition, add an asterisk in front of Inert Ingredients. Place another asterisk on the next line below "Total" and add "Contains petroleum distillates."
