
This registration notice is being issued in accordance with Section 3(c)(7)(A) of the FIFRA subject to the following conditions.

The following requirements or revisions apply to the label which was accepted with this registration notice:

1. The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Reg. No. 15127-17. This registration is being issued with the understanding that the derivative of cyanuric acid which is contained in this product is under scrutiny for potential adverse effects to human. There may be some regulatory actions directed against all registered products containing this chemical as an active ingredient at some time in the future.
2. Two copies of the finished printed labels, as defined in the A-79 enclosure, must be submitted to the Agency before the product is released for shipment to comply with PR Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982.
3. The finished printed labels must comply with the general labeling requirements of Section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. If the label does not satisfy these requirements it will be rejected.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS (PLEASE READ)**

1. This product has a powerful chlorine odor. Hold away from face when opening to avoid breathing fumes.
2. Prolonged contact between this product in its undissolved state and vinyl liners or painted surfaces will result in bleaching of the vinyl or paint.
3. When adding this product to skimmer or feeder make sure there are no other chemicals present as a violent reaction may occur. It is always dangerous to mix chemicals.
4. Use this product as directed as per instructions on label. Do not take advice from others or experiment by yourself.
5. If this product is used to shock or superchlorinate a pool after treatment it is important to brush walls and floor to expose algae that may be in cracks or wrinkles that might protect algae from high chlorine residual. Such protected algae will begin to reproduce again when high chlorine residual falls.
6. This product, because of its potent formulation, can be dangerous if not used properly. Do not mix with any other chemicals. This could result in a violent chemical reaction. Do not add water to this product in a closed container. Do not add this product to a small amount of water in a pail. When adding this product to skimmer, make sure pump is on and water circulating so that material is drawn into recirculation system. Do not allow build up of dry material in skimmer as gases may generate and cause an explosion.

**DIRECT**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product without its labeling.

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2 - 7.6 for copper plumbing, best pH for most pools.
2. If the pool has not been properly stabilized (cyanuric acid), follow the instructions on the label for that product.
3. Secure chlorinator in the area of the pool. If residual remains further from the agitator area, add more tablets.
4. In newly filled pools, follow the instructions on the label for 7 oz. tablets or 28" x 7" oz. tablets. A chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm is required to maintain the pool. Thereafter, add one 7 oz. tablet per week or as needed to maintain all times as determined by a test kit.

**Please Note:** The pH of 7 Day Slow Tabs to reduce the pH and alkalinity should be maintained at pH 7.2 to 7.6 as of sodium carbonate or sodium bicarbonate.

**STORAGE**

Keep product dry in a tightly sealed container. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area. Decomposition, isolate containers with large amounts of water. Rinse containers thoroughly with water. Place in trash collection.
