When used as directed, MEAN GREEN will deodorize surfaces in toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause mal odors.

Storage and Disposal

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

MEAN GREEN is a proven "one-step" cleaner, disinfectant, sanitizer, fungicide, mildewstat virucide in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil.

Apply MEAN GREEN to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as table, chairs, countertops, sinks and bedframes with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection: To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces, add 2 oz. per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes.

The activity of MEAN GREEN has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum by the AOAC use dilution test and found to be effective against a broad spectrum of gram negative and gram positive organisms as presented by:

Fungicidal Performance
MEAN GREEN is effective against Trichophyton trichophyllum (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise areas, dressing rooms, etc., at 2 oz. per gallon.

Mold and Mildew Control At 2 oz. per gallon, MEAN GREEN will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces (as indicated in general instructions above). Allow to dry on surface and repeat when mildew growth returns.

Virucidal Performance At 2 oz. per gallon use-level, MEAN GREEN was evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against the following viruses: Influenza A-Brazil, Herpes Simplex and Vaccinia, on inanimate environmental surfaces.

Sanitizing-Non-Food Contact Surfaces (such as floors, walls, tables, etc.). At 5 oz. per 4.5 gallon use-level, 30 second contact time, MEAN GREEN is an effective sanitizing agent against Staphylococcus aureus and Klebsiella pneumoniae in the presence of 5% serum on porous and non-porous environmental surfaces.
