## **STERILIZATION or DISINFECTION**

Instruments, tools, objects and needles should be thoroughly cleaned, rinsed and drained before entering the SONACIDE system.

Immobilized agents will be sterilized in SONACIDE solution at 121°C for 60 minutes. Remove and rinse with sterile water. This is a 10-minute cycle to prepare the agent for testing of vaccine and tuberculin activity.
