To eliminate odors: Shake well. Hold upright. Spray upward toward center of room during 2-3 seconds.

To control mold & mildew: Spray until moist and repeat weekly to prevent regrowth.

Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Before using on painted or plastic surfaces, spot test on an inconspicuous area.

If in eyes flush for 15 minutes and get medical attention.

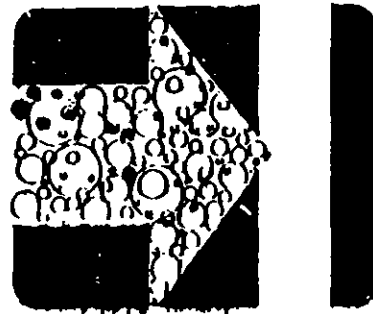
