Your Amendment Application Dated July 9, 1987

The submitted efficacy data are adequate to support effectiveness of the product as a virucide against Respiratory Syncytial Virus and Cytomegalovirus-Davis when sprayed to thoroughly wet precleaned, hard, nonporous surfaces for a contact time of 10 minutes at 22 °C.

However, in the future virus inoculum on a hard surface carrier must be dried for at least 20 to 60 minutes at 35 to 37 °C.

The amendment is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under section 3(c)(5) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Change "Rhinovirus type 1a" to read "Rhinovirus type 1A" and "Cytomegalovirus-Davis" to read "Cytomegalovirus."
 - b. The misuse statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" should be placed directly below the DIRECTIONS heading.



DIRECTIONS:

FOR USE IN HOSPITALS, CLINICS, AND HOMES. Use Wavecide 06 to decontaminate pre-cleaned hard surfaces such as floors, walls, tabletops, telephones, carts, laundry carriers, and bathroom facilities.

TO DISINFECT: Shake well. Hold can upright 6" to 8" from surface and spray until covered with mist. Allow to stand 10 minutes.

TO ELIMINATE ODORS: Shake well. Hold can upright. Spray towards center of room for 2 to 3 seconds.

TO CONTROL MOLD AND MILDEW: Spray surfaces until moist and allow to stand 10 minutes. Repeat weekly to prevent regrowth.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with eyes and food. Before using on painted or plastic surfaces, spot test on an inconspicuous area.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If sprayed into eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
