KILLS or REPELS

Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Stable Flies, Mosquitoes,
Face Flies, Horn Flies, House Flies, Gnats and Ticks.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For best results apply 1/2 to 1 oz. twice daily with a trigger type hand pumped sprayer. This method is fast and provides even distribution over the entire animal. Continue treatment even in wet weather. Treat all horses in the stable.

Until the horse learns the value of FLY-CURB a cloth may be used to apply it. Dampen the cloth with the sprayer in the horse's presence to accustom animal to it's sound. By pumping the trigger gently the hissing which alarms some horses does not occur. The horse will usually accept direct spraying after a few applications. Spray may be directed into gnat irritated ears and onto fly-caused skin irritations.

The routine of spraying twice daily should be followed regardless of weather to achieve maximum fly reduction.

CAUTION: HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED

If swallowed call a physician immediately. Do NOT induce vomiting. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not wet the skin of animals. Wash hands with soap after applying. Do not reuse container; destroy when empty.

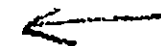

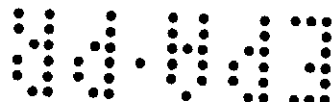
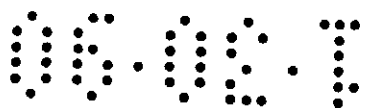
