Remove earth from around pole to a depth of 18 inches. Use a steel brush to remove dirt and loose, decayed wood. It is recommended increment borings be taken to determine if decay exists in the center of the pole. These holes shold be plugged with treated wood pluce. Inspect pole for extent of decay, if found to be sub-standard it should be replaced. Pol-Grease should be applied at 1/4 inch thickness. It may be applied to waterproof paper by brush, swab or mechanical devices designed to make preservative bandages.Pol-Grease may be spoiled directly to the pole by brush or swab. Then, the treated area should be wrapped with waterproof paper before backtilling the hole.
