## DIRECTIONS

To control Sapstain and Mold in softwoods, best results will be obtained if the lumber is dipped within 24 hours after cutting. If lumber is not dipped within 24 hours, interior stain may develop.

For lumber 2" or less in thickness, dissolve 7 lbs. of CHEMTOX-7 in 100 U.S. gallons of water. For thicker lumber or timber or severe conditions favorable to the growth of sapstain and mold, dissolve 7 lbs. of CHEMTOX-7 in 50 - 75 U.S. gallons of water. A dip of 15 seconds or more is sufficient.

The treating solution should be carefully prepared in a separate container and then poured into the dipping vat or spray tank. After adding the dry chemical to the water, the mixture should be stirred until dissolved. To avoid dust, bags should be immersed below water level and then opened.

In order to insure best results, the vat or tank must be protected from dilution by rain. Treated lumber should not be allowed to remain unprotected in heavy rain, especially just after dipping.

Approved stacking practice should be employed with adequate space between boards and stacks. Green or infected wood should not be used for stickers. The bottom of the stacks should be well above the ground with weeds and debris kept away from the stacks.
