

Low foam microbicide-15 is used to control algae, bacteria, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove algae, slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 14.8 fluid ounces of Low foam microbicide-15

per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 32 to 32 Low foam microbicide-15, based on

in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dosage of 1.0 to 1.0 Low foam microbicide-15 per 1000 gallons

80 parts per million of Low foam microbicide-15 should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water.

Low foam microbicide-15 is used to clean air-washing systems that maintain effective mist eliminators. To its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 14.8 to 14.8 Low foam microbicide-15 per 1000 gallons

is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident. Dosages of 10.1 to 24.7 fluid ounces of Low foam microbicide-15 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each 1 to 2 weeks.

frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made to collection trays of the airwash system.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
