HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness in swimming pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE.

HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE

For pools having just visible algae growth add an amount of HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE to move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of swimming pools add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE per 10,000 gallons should be made every 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE is composed of chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine in the water. However, do not mix HEAVY DUTY ALGICIDE with liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container.
