We are not aware of the purpose of lanolin in cattle sprays nor are we aware of livestock owners brushing and bathing these animals prior to application of a cattle spray. Please explain.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.





DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

On Dogs - kills fleas up to 14 days and ticks up to 4 days.
On Cats - kills fleas up to 14 days and ticks up to 9 days.

Spray the animal from a distance of 8-12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. Wet ticks thoroughly. Repeat as needed.

For cats apply at the rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long haired dogs.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat and open flame. Store above 32°F and protect from freezing.

Disposal: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
