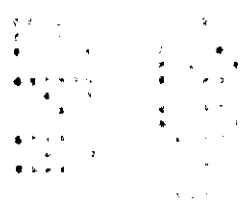

Fluff the hair as you spray so the spray will penetrate to the skin. Wet ticks thoroughly. Repeat every 7 days, if needed. For cats apply at the rate of 1 second per pound of body weight. For dogs apply at the rate of 2 seconds per pound of body weight for thin or short dogs and up to 8 seconds per pound of body weight for heavy or long haired dogs.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

Do not use on puppies or kittens under 3 months of age.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat and open flame. Store above 32°F and protect from freezing.
