

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

To kill fleas, lice and ticks: Dilute 1 fluid ounce of the liquid concentrate with one gallon of water. Mix until thoroughly mixed. Take up entire amount thoroughly wet **WITH** skin. This treatment must be repeated frequently. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth. Do not apply more than the dose, or as necessary.

For control of fleas, ticks and lice: Repeat application every two days, or as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Carefully wrap original container in several layers of new paper and discard in trash.
