DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dip animal thoroughly wet to the skin. For control of ear mites, while dipping, lightly sponge inside of ears. Do not rinse. Towel Dry. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in cool locked area. Protect from freezing. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap in several layers of newspaper.

If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get immediate medical attention.

If on skin: Wash with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Note to Physician: Atropine Sulfate is antidotal only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present.
