DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

DOGS & CATS: Cover animal's eyes with hand and spray head,
 ears, and chest until damp. With fingertips rub into face
 around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, body and legs,
 for best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray
 against the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired dogs and
 cats rub hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the
 ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray
 through wet ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES & KITTENS: Spray only along back or on your fingertips and rub into coat. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 4 weeks of age.

ON PREMISES: Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals if recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and direct sunlight.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing of spray misting. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid contact with animal's eyes. Do not use on nursing animals. Avoid spraying food or foodstuffs. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Contact a physician or local Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: wash with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.
