#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Chemical Treatment C-2185 is a tabletted product designed to dissolve slowly providing a continuous source of chlorine for controlling the growth of bacteria and algae in industrial reorculating water cooling towers, air washers, and evaporative condensers.

Badly fouled systems should be cleaned prior to initiating treatment.

INITIAL DOSAGE: When the system is just noticeably fouled, immerse 0.4-0.5 lbs. of C-2185 per 10,000 gallons of water contained in the system. Repeat this initial dosage if necessary until the chlorine demand is satisfied and a chlorine residual of 0.5 to 1.0 ppm (as determined by use of a chlorine test) is established.

SUBSEQUENT DOSAGE: To maintain a chlorine residual of 0.5 to 1.0 ppm, add 0.8 to 1.6 ounces of C-2185 per 10,000 gallons of water daily or as needed as determined by use of a chlorine test.

C-2185 should be immersed in the system at a point where adequate flow is maintained. Variations in water temperature, chlorine demand, and flow rate will affect the dissolution rate of the tablets. During warmer seasons, the growth of algae and bacteria may increase requiring upward adjustment of chlorine residuals.

### STORAGE AND DIS OSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area, or bury in a safe place.
