### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

71L is a bactericide and algacide for bacteria, slime and algae in open circulating systems.

This product is used only when tower growth becomes visible.

When algae and bacteria growth become visible, dose with 2 pints of 71L per 50 operating tons. Slug feed directly into the basin of the tower and circulate for 24 hours. Bleedoff valves should be closed. Any tower treatment should be discontinued while using 71L.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CORROSIVE:** Causes eye damage. May produce severe burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin with goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapor or mist.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.
