DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Spray infested surfaces only until wet. **ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVER FISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, EARWIGS:** Spray heavily into all cracks around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Also spray until wet surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required. **CARPET BEETLES:** Make localized applications to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks or closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary. **BROWN DOG TICKS:** Thoroughly spray infested areas around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localize areas of floors and floor coverings. Applications should be repeated as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this formulation.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, and window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

WASPS: For outdoor use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, and window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Spray the nest in the evening when the insects have congregated and are less active.

FLEAS, CHIGGERS, ANTS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas where there is no vegetation. Spray as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
Minimum flash point: 167 F.
Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.
