

For Manufacturing Purposes Only

CONTENTS
GALLONS

Active Ingredient DINOSEB (2-sec-butyl 4,6-dinitrophenol)	minimum 97%
Inert Ingredients	maximum 3



Symptoms of Poisoning - Excessive salivation, sweating, diarrhea and fever. Symptoms of poisoning develop from any type of exposure. Send for a physician.

FIRST AID - If swallowed, induce vomiting if possible. Do not allow the patient to swallow before compresses or by immersion in cool water.

If swallowed - Give Epsom salt (Magnesium Sulfate) in quantity sufficient to cause diarrhoea of table salt in a glass of warm water, repeat until diarrhoea occurs, then give two teaspoonsful of liquid paraffin caps of warm water. Treat as in FIRST AID above.

If splashed in eyes, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention. If spilled on skin immediately remove contaminated clothing, including shoes, and wash skin with soap and plenty of water. If symptoms of poisoning develop, send for a physician and treat as in FIRST AID above. Discard contaminated clothing and shoes, or clean them thoroughly before reuse. NOTE TO ATTENDING PHYSICIAN - Active ingredient is a nitrophenol compound. Treat Symptomatically.

DE-PRECATION

To avoid staining of carpeting, linoleum, etc., keep containers tightly closed and never store until cleaned. Do not contain water, sand or irrigation or forest purposes. Discard of empty containers by puncturing them and burying with wastes.
