On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Submit an acceptable acute inhalation study (Guideline 81-3) or an acceptable justification for waiving this requirement. We acknowledge receipt of your October 2, 1995 request to waive the acute inhalation study. The Agency is currently reviewing your request and will notify you of our decision regarding the need for an acute inhalation study once the review is completed.
3. Make the following label changes:
  - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. "15440-23".

- b. Delete the last sentence of the paragraph under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" which begins "Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact ...". This dermal sensitization statement is inappropriate, since the product has been classified as a non-sensitizer.
  
- c. Revise the second sentence of the "Container Disposal" instructions to read as follows: "Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning."

Additional label revision may be necessary upon completion of our review of the information required in item 2, above.

4. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
